

LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

REGULAR MEETING

February 2, 2021 @ 5:30 P.M.

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, February 2, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. Present were, Chairman Jimmy Rogers, Commissioners Trae Kemp, Brenda Chain, Jeff Davis, and Kevin Tanner, County Administrator Bryan Rogers and County Attorney Billy Kight. Commissioner Trae Kemp gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item was the approval of the minutes of the January 12, 2021 regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Trae Kemp made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Brenda Chain seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to adopt Personnel Policy Amendments. The amendments clarified several policy issues such as the policy concerning paid accrued vacation time upon separation. See attached exhibit "A". Commissioner Kevin Tanner made the motion to adopt the Personnel Policy Amendments. Commissioner Trae Kemp seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the creation of the Cleared Drug Account. This account will be utilized for drug forfeiture funds and is a new GASB requirement. Commissioner Brenda Chain made a motion to approve the creation of Cleared Drug Account. Commissioner Kevin Tanner second the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Fiscal Agent Status for Family Connection. This has to be renewed each fiscal year. They are current with all reimbursements. Commissioner Jeff Davis made the motion to approve the Fiscal Agent Status for Family Connection. Commissioner Brenda Chain second the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Amendment to the Rehab Residential Home Ordinance. The current ordinance will be revised to require each facility to have current GAAR certification by July 1, 2021. It will also require that each facility be in compliance with the On-Site Sewage Management Ordinance as it applies to commercial establishments instead of residential by January 1, 2022. Commissioner Kevin Tanner made the motion to approve the Amendment to Rehab Residential Home Ordinance. Commissioner Trae Kemp second the motion. Chairman Jimmy Rogers, Commissioner Kevin Tanner, Commissioner Jeff Davis, and Commissioner Trae Kemp all voted in favor. Commissioner Brenda Chain abstained.

The next item was to approve the Adoption of Roads in Harbour Oaks Subdivision. These roads were built years ago and were built in compliance with county road standards in that they have 60 foot of right of way with a 20-foot paved road bed. They consist of Briargate Dr., Bluestone Dr., and Briarwater Dr. Commissioner Kevin Tanner made the motion to approve the Adoption of Roads in Harbour Oaks Subdivision. Commissioner Brenda Chain second the motion. All voted in favor.
