

LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

REGULAR MEETING

June 2, 2020 @ 5:30 P.M.

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, June 2 at 5:30 p.m. Present were, Chairman Brenda Chain, Commissioners Trae Kemp, Kevin Tanner, Jimmy Rogers, and Jeff Davis, County Administrator Bryan Rogers and County Attorney Billy Kight. County Administrator Bryan Rogers gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item was the approval of the minutes of the May 5, 2020 regular meeting. Commissioner Jeff Davis made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Trae Kemp seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the EMS Rate Structure. Commissioner Kevin Tanner made the motion to approve the EMS Rate Structure. Commissioner Jimmy Rogers seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the West Adrian Cell Tower Site. Southern Linc has requested site approval to build a cell tower off Thomas Chapel Road. Commissioner Kevin Tanner made the motion to approve the West Adrian Cell Tower Site. Commissioner Jeff Davis second the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Turner Lane Special Tax District. The road is located in Northwoods Trail subdivision. There would be 9 lots included in the special tax district paying a special tax of \$750 each for a 5-year period. Chairman Brenda Chain ask if anyone was present for or against the special tax district. There being no response, Commissioner Jimmy Rogers made the motion to approve the Turner Lane Special Tax District. Commissioner Trae Kemp second the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Airport Resolution for Cares Act Funding. Laurens County qualifies for \$30,000 in funding from the feds for the Airport. Commissioner Jeff Davis made the motion to approve the resolution. Commissioner Trae Kemp second the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Development Authority Appointment. The term of Jimmy Allgood is up on June 30th. He desires to be re-appointed. Commissioner Kevin Tanner made the motion to approve the Development Authority Appointment. Commissioner Trae Kemp second the motion. All voted in favor.

OTHER BUSINESS:

County Administrator Bryan Rogers asked that we surplus a 2007 Chevrolet Truck. It is salvage and has over 350,000 miles on it. Commissioner Jimmy Rogers made the motion to approve to surplus the truck. Commissioner Trae Kemp second the motion. All voted in favor.

Rufus Hill wanted to thank Commissioner Kevin Tanner for resurfacing Willie Wood Road. He really appreciates all the County has done.

Tiffany Cooper expressed her concerns about Woodfield Dr and Southwoods Lane. It is a private road and she wants the county to put it in a special tax district so the road can get fixed. She explained that there are very bad washouts.

Clay with Southern Linc asked if they approved the cell tower location. County Administrator Bryan Rogers responded and told him we did approve the location.
