

LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

REGULAR MEETING

July 7, 2020 @ 5:30 P.M.

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, July 7 at 5:30 p.m. Present were, Chairman Brenda Chain, Commissioners Trae Kemp, Jimmy Rogers, and Jeff Davis, and County Attorney Billy Kight. Commissioner Kevin Tanner and County Administrator Bryan Rogers were absent. Commissioner Jeff Davis gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item was the approval of the minutes of the June 2, 2020 regular meeting and June 29, 2020 called meeting. Commissioner Jeff Davis made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes and called meeting minutes. Commissioner Trae Kemp seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the new beer/wine license at Motions Bar and Grill. County Attorney Billy Kight pointed out to the Commissioners that there had been many problems at this location in the past including serious crimes and traffic congestion; however, the new license holder had met all requirements for the new license and hired private security. He also mentioned that if similar problems arose, the Board could once again pull the license at this location. Commissioner Jeff Davis made the motion to approve the new beer/wine license. Commissioner Trae Kemp seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
