

# **LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

## **CALLED MEETING**

**August 22, 2023 @ 12:00 P.M.**

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held a called meeting on Tuesday, August 22, 2023, at 12:00 p.m. Present were, Chairman Jeff Davis, Commissioners Kevin Tanner, Brenda Chain, Jimmy Rogers, Trae Kemp, County Administrator Bryan Rogers and County Attorney Billy Kight. Commissioner Trae Kemp gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item was the discussion/approval of the Re-Insurance Carrier. County Administrator Bryan Rogers explained to the Board that the current re-insurance plan premium is \$833,000 with our specific set at \$100,000 per claim. Three quotes were received and due to medical inflation and the bad claims experience from the past year, the premiums were much higher. Mr. Rogers recommended the quote from the current carrier, One 80, which increased the premium to \$1,250,023 with no new laser provisions. Commissioner Trae Kemp made a motion to approve the One 80, option 1 premium for \$1,250,023. Commissioner Jimmy Rogers seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was the discussion/approval of Sheriff Department Request for Surplus Property. The Sheriff's Department would like to surplus six vehicles. Commissioner Kevin Tanner made a motion to table the surplus of the vehicles until they could be inspected by the Board. Commissioner Brenda Chain seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
