From south of State Route 46 to south of State Route 117

Project Update

In fall 2018, GDOT announced that it is considering improvements to US 441 in Laurens County, including the widening of the roadway on its existing alignment between SR 46 (north of McRae) to SR 117 (south of Dublin) to create a four-lane road (two lanes in each direction) divided by a 32-foot wide median (see Project Area Map). Since then, the project team has been working to complete preliminary designs of the US 441 corridor improvements. The team has also completed environmental surveys for Archaeology, Ecology, and History.

The project now also includes improvements to the SR 46 and US 441 intersection to address identified operational issues. Topographic and environmental surveys will be completed for this intersection in Spring 2020.

The public can now review the project concepts and provide comment at the upcoming in-person open houses below.


Project Information Open Houses

After hearing from the public, GDOT will make any necessary adjustments to the preliminary design and continue environmental analysis. After preliminary plans are complete, GDOT will begin to acquire right-of-way for the project followed by geotechnical investigations and final design.
