

The Laurens County Board of Elections and Registration met on Monday, February 3, 2025 in the Elections and Registration Office for their regular monthly meeting. Present were David Gay, Chair, Christine Baker, Vice Chair and Board Members, Keith Alligood, Alan Scarbrough and Gladine White. Susan Rooks, Election Supervisor was also present.

Call to Order.

Visitors were welcomed.

The minutes of the January 6, 2025 meeting were approved as submitted. Keith Alligood motioned to approve and Gladine White seconded.

The expenditures were approved as submitted. Alan Scarbrough motioned to approve and Christine Baker seconded.

OLD BUSINESS: Susan stated that Genola Jackson, Probate Judge, had turned over a majority of the election records from her office.

NEW BUSINESS: Susan stated that she had been in contact with Ethics and is now set up to E-File. She also stated that she had mailed all current elected officials a letter and the Personal Financial Disclosure Statement form to be completed and returned to be E-Filed. She informed the Board of a security change to allow access to the basement area of the courthouse where the election records are stored. She, Jennifer and Jeanie had each completed a form for admittance. Susan said that she had contacted Greg Whiten with Easy Vote Solutions about an E-File program for qualifying candidates and all other filing statements. He will be sending a Team View program for us to watch and see if this is something we would want to invest in. The cost would be approximately \$3,000.00 per year. This program was highly recommended by several Election Superintendents who attended our recent Regional meeting.
