

# **LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

## **REGULAR MEETING**

**January 3, 2023 @ 5:30 P.M.**

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, January 3, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. Present were, Vice-Chairman Trae Kemp, Commissioners Kevin Tanner, Brenda Chain, Jimmy Rogers, County Administrator Bryan Rogers and County Attorney Billy Kight.
