

LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

REGULAR MEETING

March 2, 2021 @ 5:30 P.M.

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, March 2, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. Present were, Chairman Jimmy Rogers, Commissioners Trae Kemp, Brenda Chain, and Kevin Tanner, County Administrator Bryan Rogers and County Attorney Billy Kight. Commissioner Jeff Davis was absent. Commissioner Trae Kemp gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item was the approval of the minutes of the February 2, 2021 regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Trae Kemp made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Brenda Chain seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Land Bank Appointments. The terms of Michael Maffett and Matt Sweat are up. They both desire to be re-appointed. Commissioner Trae Kemp made the motion to approve the Land Bank Appointments. Commissioner Brenda Chain seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Budget Amendments. These amendments are to clean up the FY 2020 budget. They stem from receiving more revenue from grants and other projects that required us to increase expenditures. Commissioner Kevin Tanner made a motion to approve the Budget Amendments. Commissioner Trae Kemp second the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve Surplus Equipment. We need to surplus the Old Low Boy truck and other pieces of equipment. The Sheriff's Department also wants to surplus several vehicles with high mileage and they have several outside agencies that would like to purchase them. Commissioner Kevin Tanner made the motion to approve the surplus of the equipment and vehicles as presented. Commissioner Brenda Chain second the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Contract for revising property schedules. The Assessor's office recommends we enter into a contract with GMASS to update the property schedules that are utilized for determining property values. The cost will be \$102,000. This money will be taken out of our fund balance. Commissioner Trae Kemp made the motion to approve the Contract for Property Schedules. Commissioner Kevin Tanner second the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the FY 2020 Financial Statements. This item will be tabled until a later date.

OTHER BUSINESS:

County Administrator Bryan Rogers expressed that the market for recycling has gone up. He would like to expand the recycling from cardboard and metal to include #1 and #2 plastic and aluminum and tin cans. Recycling would be available at 4 centers in the County. Commissioner Trae Kemp made the motion to expand the recycling. Commissioner Kevin Tanner second the motion.
