

LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

REGULAR MEETING

June 1, 2021 @ 5:30 P.M.

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, June 1, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. Present were, Chairman Jimmy Rogers, Commissioners Trae Kemp, Brenda Chain, Jeff Davis, and Kevin Tanner, County Administrator Bryan Rogers and County Attorney Billy Kight. Chairman Jimmy Rogers gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item was the approval of the minutes of the May 4, 2021 regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Brenda Chain made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes and called meeting minutes. Commissioner Trae Kemp seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Special Tax District at Matts Drive. This subdivision is located in District 2 and consists of 7 lots. Over half the property owners have responded favorably to being charged the special assessment of \$500 per year for five years. Commissioner Trae Kemp made the motion to approve the Special Tax District at Matts Drive. Commissioner Kevin Tanner seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Special Tax District at Southwood Subdivision. This subdivision is located in District 2 and consists of 33 lots. Over half the property owners have responded favorably to being charged the special assessment of \$275 per year for five years. Commissioner Trae Kemp made a motion to approve the Special Tax District at Southwood Subdivision. Commissioner Jeff Davis seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Development Authority Appointment. Phil Gay's appointment expires on June 30, 2021. He desires to be re-appointed. Commissioner Kevin Tanner made the motion to approve the Development Authority Appointment. Commissioner Trae Kemp seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the DFCS Appointment. Mrs. Margaret Pauldo has asked to resign her position from this Board due to personal reasons. Chairman Rogers moved to table the appointment for further consideration.

The next item was to approve the Region 5 EMS Council Appointment. Terry Cobb is our representative and desires to be re-appointed. Commissioner Jeff Davis made the motion to approve the Region 5 EMS Council Appointment. Commissioner Kevin Tanner seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Prosecuting Attorney Council Agreement. This is to renew the existing agreement with PAC and is for the payment of funds to the DA's office for the circuit employees. Commissioner Brenda Chain made the motion to approve the Prosecuting Attorney Council Agreement. Commissioner Trae Kemp seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
