

# LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

## REGULAR MEETING

**August 3, 2021 @ 5:30 P.M.**

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, August 3, 2021, at 5:30 p.m. Present were, Chairman Jimmy Rogers, Commissioners Trae Kemp, Brenda Chain, Jeff Davis, and Kevin Tanner, County Administrator Bryan Rogers. County Attorney Billy Kight was absent. Chairman Jimmy Rogers gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item was the approval of the minutes of the July 6, 2021, regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Trae Kemp made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Brenda Chain seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve new Beer and Wine License at 806 Ben Hall Lake Road. Commissioner Kevin Tanner made the motion to approve the Beer and Wine License. Commissioner Trae Kemp seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Cell Tower at 2851 South Poplar Springs Church Road. Verizon applied for a new cell tower permit at the location and performed the necessary due diligence to show the need for the new tower in that location. Commissioner Trae Kemp made a motion to approve the Cell Tower at 2851 South Poplar Springs Church Road. Commissioner Brenda Chain seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the DFCS Appointment. Elgin Dixon has expressed a desire to serve on the Board replacing Mrs. Pauldo who stepped down due to health reasons. Commissioner Brenda Chain made the motion to approve the DFCS Appointment. Commissioner Jeff Davis seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

### OTHER BUSINESS:

Alan Baggett with the Sheriff's Department wanted to trade in two F150's that both have around 90,000 miles. They were 34,000 new and the trade in value is \$28,000. Commissioner Trae Kemp made the motion to approve the trade in for trucks. Commissioner Kevin Tanner seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
